Your children will recently have received a couple of reminder/prompt emails from Unifrog.


This is a careers platform that we will be utilising moving forward with all students in school.

I recently emailed regarding this, but wanted to extend my encouragement towards using the platform at home.

This letter will very briefly give you an overview of the platform and how it will be used in school. I will also cover how you can use this as a fun and effective way to foster conversations at home.

Student profiles

Every student, once logged in, will have a profile page. It looks like the image below.
